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Introduction:

Ramireddy Subbarami Reddy Educational Trust, Kavali was setup in the year 2007. Under this trust, Ramireddy Subbarami Reddy Engineering College, Kadanuthala was promoted.

Mr. R PRATAP KUMAR REDDY who is a renowned educationalist and philanthropist is the chairman of the institution.
